(Alternative woggles Type 1)

The picture below shows how to make a Woggle from an empty shotgun shell. The black drawn on lines show where to cut the shell. You can try experimenting with different heights of cut to get the best results for your materials. Generally the higher the cut, the flatter the Necker and Woggle will lay, but it makes the Woggle weaker. Use a sharp knife, and heat it in a candle flame so it will melt through the plastic. It is possible to cut the shell without heating the knife, but the plastic is very tough and it is easy to slip and cut yourself, or ruin the Woggle. You can either leave the Woggle plain or decorate it in any way you want using a wide variety of materials.
